This letter is to invite you to a debate on April 11, 2018 beginning at 6 pm, which will last for one hour. The debate will occur at KPVM, Channel 46, in Pahrump, and be televised. My campaign will pay for the cost of the media time. In the interest of fairness, I have requested that no political commercials be aired during this debate.

We have invited Deanna O'Donnell, of KPVM, to moderate. All questions will come from her, with no input from the campaigns, or the public. The questions will be issue-based only, with no personal attack questions. Each candidate will stand at their own podium, and each candidate is expected to be mindful of the time clock and polite to the moderator.

Each campaign may bring one person to the studio with them, but this person will be in the sound booth and not on the studio floor during the debate. No cell phones or other forms of electronic equipment will be in the studio with any candidate during this hour. The moderator will provide each candidate with paper and a pen to use to take notes during the debate as the debate begins.

The format is to be as follows:

- 1. A card draw will determine the starting order.
- 2. Each candidate will receive up to 1 minute for their introduction.
- 3. There will be no rebuttal for opening statements
- 4. Each candidate will be allowed up to 90 seconds to answer each question.
- 5. Rebuttal time will be up to one minute
- 6. Each candidate will have the option of rebutting each question
- 7. Each candidate will be allowed to rebut one time for each question
- 8. Each candidate will have up to 2 minutes to make their closing arguments
